## Ohio High School Community Service



- Beginning the 2013-2014 school year, 20 hours of community service will be a graduation requirement for high school students. Students must complete 5 hours per year to move to the next grade.
- All students must have the activity pre-approved by the superintendent, principal, or guidance counselor and submitted to the school when completed. A copy of the application is on the back.
- Approved activities include the following: Non-profit organizationschurches, hospitals, municipalities, school, etc. Any catastrophic situation- fire, flood, etc. Any elderly or handicapped individual who is not capable of doing the work.
- The elderly or handicapped individual cannot be a relative.
- The non-profit organization supervisor cannot be a relative.
- Community Service means no salary can be received.
- School activities, such as working the concession stand, cannot be counted as community service hours.
- None of the 20 hours can be done on school time. Students need to complete the hours after school, on weekends, or during the summer time.
