It is very important that you tune to the following radio and TV stations in the event school is cancelled or released early:

RADIO: 99.3 FM; 98.1 FM; 1490 AM; 102.1 FM; 106.1 FM; 100.1 FM; 97.7 FM; 103.3 FM; 100.9 FM; 1250 AM. TV: WQAD—Channel 8 News and KWQC - Channel 6 (Quad Cities).

Although we are part way through the winter, we want to remind you of a few items related to bad weather. Please make sure your child is dressed properly when leaving for school. You will receive an "All Call" or text message alert when we are delaying, dismissing or cancelling school. Please make sure we have your correct phone number at all times. If you are not receiving the alerts, please call the office immediately. Please make arrangements for your child in the case of a delay, early dismissal or cancellation.

The bus may run late on bad weather days. If it is rainy, extremely cold, or blowing snow we encourage you to have your child wait at the door until you see the bus coming before sending them outside. Some parents have driven their child to the end of the drive and waited in the warm car for the bus to arrive. You always have the option to drive your child to school. If your child is not riding the bus, make sure you call the school so the driver knows.

5 Essentials Survey

Dear Parents,

Beginning **January 24**, students and teachers across Illinois will have an opportunity to participate in the ninth annual statewide Illinois 5Essentials Survey. This survey is designed to generate a detailed picture of the inner workings of your child's school. As a parent, this opportunity will allow you to share your thoughts on the important elements of school effectiveness in a survey about your child's school.

On behalf of the Illinois State Board of Education, the Illinois 5Essentials Survey will be administered online by UChicago Impact at the University of Chicago. The survey gathers data related to five indicators that can predict important student outcomes, including improved attendance and larger test score gains. These five indicators that affect and predict school success are:

- · Effective Leaders
- Collaborative Teachers
- Involved Families
- Supportive Environments
- Ambitious Instruction

Prior research in more than 400 schools has shown that schools that were strong on at least three of these "5Essential" indicators were 10 times more likely to improve student learning gains in math and reading than those that were weak on three or more Essentials.

All teachers and 4th through 12th grade students will be responding to this survey. 5Essentials Reports will be generated for schools if their teachers and/or students meet the response rate threshold of 50 percent. These reports will be sent to schools and districts in May 2023 and will also be included in the State School Report Card.

Additionally, your district has chosen to provide the optional Parent Supplement survey. If at least 20 percent of each Ohio Grade School and Ohio High School parents complete this survey, a parent supplement report will also be generated. The parent data will not be reported on the State Report Card.

Your participation in the parent portion of the survey will help us understand the conditions at your child's school and guide improvement. Your identity and survey responses will be kept completely confidential and will never be connected to you or your child.

The Illinois 5Essentials Survey for students and teachers will be conducted **January 24, 2023 through March 31, 2023.** The Parent Survey Supplement will be conducted during that same timeframe.
