- 6.4 School Maintenance Project Grant (SMPG): The SMPG is a dollar-for-dollar state matching grant program that will provide awards up to \$50,000 to grantees exclusively for the maintenance or upkeep of buildings or structures for educational purposes. The SMPG application was scheduled to open 9/5/23 but as of today 9/19/23, it was not yet available in IWAS. Applications are due 12/1/23.
- 6.5 E-Learning Plan: Our E-Learning Plan expires 9/29/23. A Resolution hearing and E-Learning Plan renewal is required for us to continue to have the flexibility to utilize E-Learning days in lieu of emergency days in the event of an extended school closure.
- Bus: We have been leasing our 29 passenger yellow bus and that lease is up. Mrs. Hamilton and I are determining if it would be more feasible to do another lease or buy the bus and also which district will purchase the bus. We will have that decision by next month's Board meeting.
