V. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- 5.1 Attendance Update: We are at 96.9% for the month of October and 96.967% average for the year.
- School Report Card Update: The Illinois State Board of Education recently released the annual Illinois Report Card. The Report Card contains school performance data from the 2023-24 school year for every public school in the state and is used to determine each school's annual Summative Designation. We are proud to say Ohio Grade School District #17 has been awarded the designation of Commendable by the Illinois State Board of Education. Other highlights: We improved our proficiency rating in both ELA and Math. Our Chronic Absenteeism rate decreased over 3% and our teacher attendance rate increased about 6%.

- Thanksgiving Feast: K-5 and Seniors will be held on November 26, 2024. Our PTO and kitchen 5.3 ladies do a great job on this.
- Pastries With Parents: Thank you to our PTO for hosting Pastries With Parents on 5.4 November 8, 2024. We had a great turnout as we have always had in the past.

- Enrollment: Pre-K thru 8: 84 students HS: 21 students TOTAL-105 6.1
- Operational Funds Report: This report includes the average expenditures over the last three years 6.2 in the educational, transportation, and operations and maintenance funds as well as the cash reserve balances for FY 24. The cash reserve balance to expenditures ratio is 1.069 which is under 2.5 so a reserve reduction plan is not required.

- Grant Update: We were allotted additional Title I funds. These additional funds will be 6.4 used to help cover some additional salary costs and a portion of our before/after school programming costs. We also got news that we have been awarded the \$50,000 School Maintenance Project Grant.
